REMEMBER!

The LEASE YOU signed states as follows:

Part XXI "SMOKE DETECTORS": "If Resident, Resident's household members or Guests damage or disconnect the smoke detector(s) or remove a battery without replacing it with a working battery, Resident may be liable to Management under Section 92.2611 of the Property Code for \$100 plus one month's rent, actual damages and attorney's fees."
